Let us confess our sin and come to God for healing.




Gracious God,

Gospel: Luke 19:45-46

This is one of the moments when Jesus is found to be angry. It appears people have lost sight of the purpose and importance of the temple.

Before the reading: The holy gospel according to Luke. Glory to you, O Lord.

After the reading: The gospel of the Lord. Praise to you, O Christ.

Reading: 1 Kings 5:1-5; 8:27-30, 41-43

I present Owen Stanley Jackson, who desires to make public affirmation of his baptism.

Let us pray...We ask this in the name of Christ. **Amen.**

I ask you to profess your faith in Christ Jesus, reject sin, and confess the faith of the church.

Do you renounce the devil and all the forces that defy God? *Confirmand responds:* I renounce them.

Do you renounce the powers of this world that rebel against God? *Confirmand responds:* I renounce them.

Do you renounce the ways of sin that draw you from God? *Confirmand responds:* I renounce them.

Do you believe in God the Father?

I believe in God, the Father almighty, creator of heaven and earth.

Do you believe in Jesus Christ, the Son of God?

I believe in Jesus Christ, God's only Son, our Lord,
who was conceived by the Holy Spirit,
born of the virgin Mary,
suffered under Pontius Pilate,
was crucified, died, and was buried;
he descended to the dead.
On the third day he rose again;
he ascended into heaven,
he is seated at the right hand of the Father,
and he will come to judge the living and the dead.

Do you believe in God the Holy Spirit?

I believe in the Holy Spirit,

the holy catholic church,
the communion of saints,
the forgiveness of sins,
the resurrection of the body,
and the life everlasting.

You have made public profession of your faith. Do you intend to continue in the covenant God made with you in holy baptism:

to live among God's faithful people,

to hear the word of God and share in the Lord's supper,

to proclaim the good news of God in Christ through word and deed,

to serve all people, following the example of Jesus,

and to strive for justice and peace in all the earth?

God feeds us with the presence of Jesus Christ.


Offering and 2025 Intents

Great Thanksgiving


The Lord be with you. **And also with you.**


